Graduate Assistantships fall into three categories: Teaching, Support, or Research. The expected weekly time commitment is 20 hours, and for teaching assistantships this translates into 6 credits a semester. If selected, the graduate assistant will sign a contract specifying the extent of service (10 or 20 hours), the contract period, the stipend, tuition remission arrangements, designated supervisor, and 15 other provisions of employment. Assistantships are reviewed annually contingent upon positive performance evaluations and are reinstated up to no more than three years. Exceptions may apply.

To be eligible for an assistantship, you must be admitted to a graduate program and enrolled in at least six credits. (Contact the Financial Aid Office directly for other financial awards). **PLEASE ATTACH RESUME** to provide specific and current information.
